

Voice Thread Assignment

In this assignment you will create a VoiceThread. A VoiceThread is a collaborative, multimedia slide show that holds images, documents, and videos and allow others to navigate the pages and leave comments in 5 ways - using voice (with a microphone or telephone), text, an audio file, or video (via a webcam).

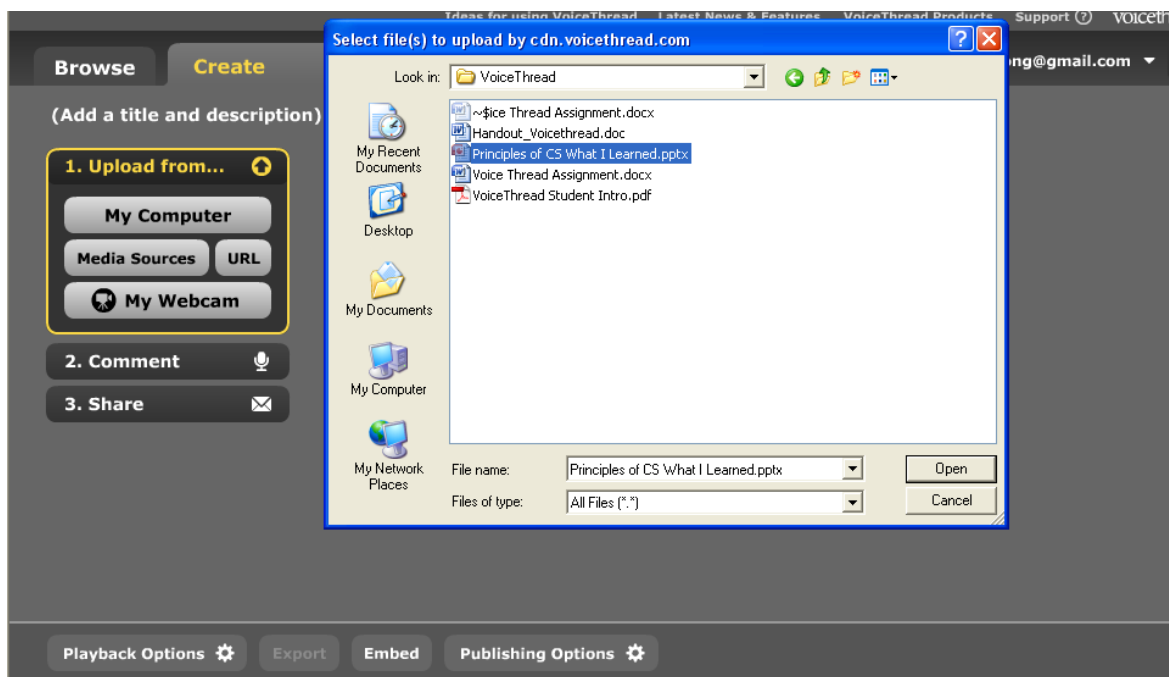
Assignment:

In this assignment you will be required to create a Powerpoint that describes “What I’ve Learned in Principles of Computer Science.” You must have a minimum of 7 slides counting one introduction slide and one conclusion slide. The other five slides must describe your experience in Principles of Computer Science. I have included a Powerpoint called “*What I’ve Learned in Principles of Computer Science*” where I have completed several slides that are examples of the types of slides I would like you to create.

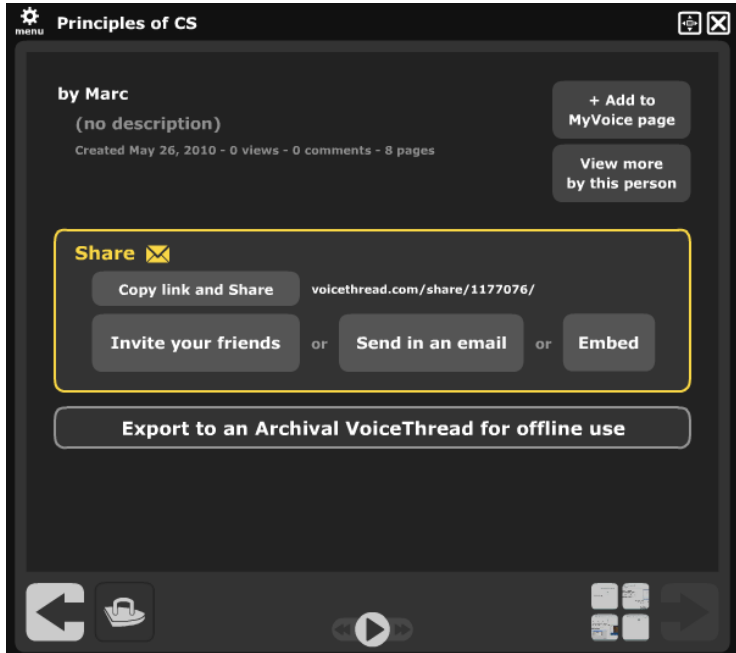
Once you have created the Powerpoint you will need to import it into a VoiceThread. However, there are several steps you will need to follow for this assignment.

Steps for Creating Your VoiceThread

- 1) Create your 5 slide PPT on “What I’ve Learned in Principles of Computer Science?”
- 2) Create a VoiceThread User Account by going to <http://www.voicethread.com>
- 3) Upload your Powerpoint by clicking on “My Computer” from the “Upload from” and select the Powerpoint you created from above. Be patient as it uploads!



- 4) Next, use your Web Cam to leave a welcome message and ask those viewing your “VoiceThread” to make comments on each slide. Explain that they are to leave comments using voice, video, or text.
- 5) Send an invitation to two other students and myself (mymarclong@gmail.com).



- 6) You will be required to leave comments on two other students’ VoiceThread from our class. Please identify yourself by your first name using audio or video as you comment on someone else’s thread. Please consider that the comments you make are as though you are making them in a public place. If the comments are questionable, they will be followed up with disciplinary action.
- 7) Upload a picture that identifies you or you identify with (keep it appropriate for school)!
- 8) View your presentation and two other student presentations. Click the Comment button to leave the desired type of comment.
